

GDPR PRIVACY RIGHTS

The General Data Protection Regulation requires that the Association of Oil Pipe Lines (AOPL) inform our E.U. users about certain specific rights:

- the right to object, for legitimate purposes, to the processing of personal data;
- the right to request copies of your personal data held by us in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and/or request us to transmit this information to another service provider (where technically feasible);
- the right to request that we delete your personal data; and
- the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

Withdrawing Consent

If you wish to withdraw your consent, please send an e-mail to aopl@aopl.org. Please note that if you withdraw consent, AOPL may not be able to provide or continue to provide certain services or communications.

Objections, Requests for Copies, and Requests for Deletion

If you wish to (i) object, for legitimate purposes, to the processing of personal data as provided under applicable law, (ii) to request copies of your personal data held by us in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and/or request us to transmit this information to another service provider (where technically feasible), or (iii) to request that AOPL delete your personal data, AOPL will promptly send you a verification email to ensure that the request was not made in error.

AOPL will respond to your request to delete your information within one month of receipt of your verification. Our response period may be extended by 60 additional days where necessary, taking into account the complexity and number of requests we receive. Please write to AOPL at the following address:
