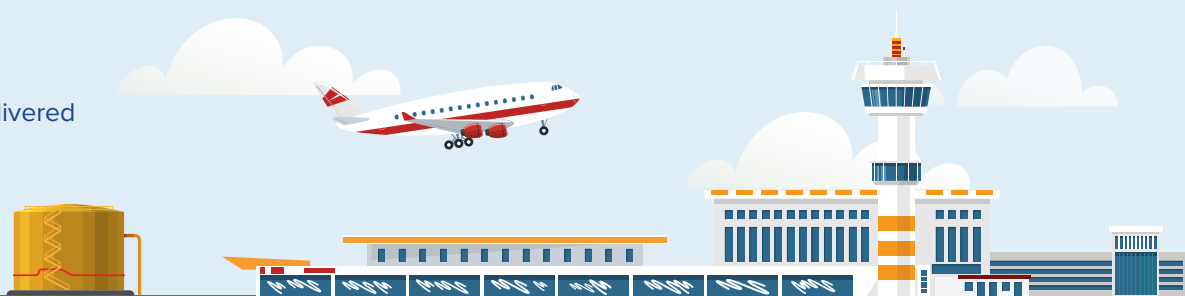


PIPELINES DELIVER FUELS YOU USE EVERY DAY

Traveling by car, truck, bus or plane requires fuels delivered by pipelines

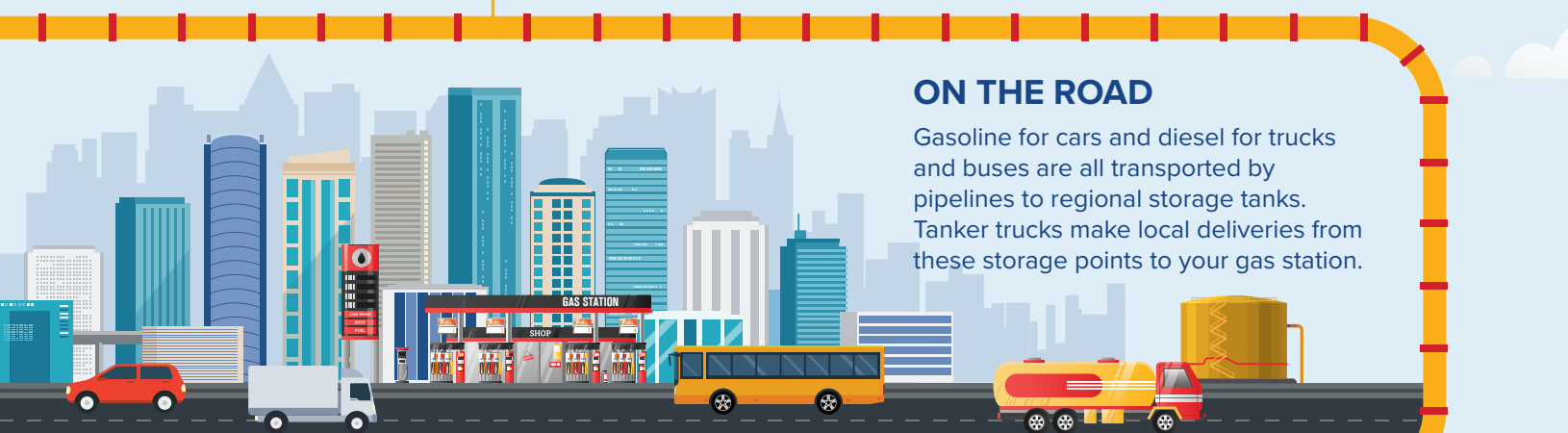
IN THE AIR

Jet fuel for airplanes is delivered to the airport by pipeline, making air travel possible.



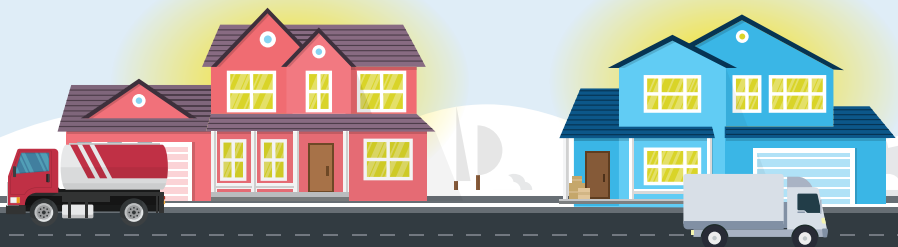
ON THE ROAD

Gasoline for cars and diesel for trucks and buses are all transported by pipelines to regional storage tanks. Tanker trucks make local deliveries from these storage points to your gas station.



AT HOME

Home heating fuel is transported by pipeline to cold-weather areas where tanker trucks complete the last leg of the delivery journey. Delivery trucks bringing packages rely on fuel transported by pipeline.



RURAL AREAS

Liquid propane for cooking and heating is delivered across rural America by pipeline. Trucks make the last leg of the delivery to residential tanks.
